


Recording Webcam Videos on a Mac

Open QuickTime Player




Record your video

- Click “File” and “New Movie Recording.”
- The webcam video feed should appear and you should now see yourself.
- To start recording, hover over the video and click on the red button.
- To stop recording, click on the gray button.



Trim your video

- If needed, trim your video by clicking “Edit” on the upper toolbar.
- Then click “Trim.”




- A bar with thumbnails and a yellow outline will appear at the bottom of your screen, (see figure).
- Drag the left edge of the yellow outline to where you want your video to begin and the right edge to the end.
- Click “Trim.”



Save your video

- Click on “File” in the menubar. Hover over “Export” and then click “720p” (or “1080p” if that is an option).
- In the pop up window, type a descriptive name and select where you want it to be saved.
- Click “Save” and the video will be saved with a .mov extension.
- This video file format can be uploaded to YouTube or Blackboard.
- Close QuickTime Player.
- A window will ask to save your file—click “Don’t Save” (since you saved in the “export” step above).
